Athletic Handbook- Issued by Poway High School Athletic Department

The Athletic Handbook contains forms that are required to receive your "Ticket to Play" (i.e., physical, Athletic Participation Signature Form, Residency, and Medical Information Release Form. These forms are to be turned in July 13th. When you turn in all necessary paperwork, you will be issued a "Ticket to Play" by the athletic department. Summer Camps – Medical Form and Waiver

We hold a five week optional summer camp starting June 12th. This camp is conducted by coaches and is open to anyone from ages 12-18. It is an opportunity to train, lift, and participate in activities designed to prepare our student-athletes for competition. This camp is not affiliated with PUSD and NOT a requirement for participation for Poway High's football team. If your decision is to be involved in this optional camp then you <u>must complete</u> the Medical form and waiver, turn in a physical done within the last year, sign up for an AAU membership, and return the forms along with your check to participate in this camp (your "Ticket to Play" is not required for this camp). The summer camp application, medical form, and waiver are located on our website.

Tuition for the summer camp is \$250 and Due by June 1st. Need based scholarships are available for the summer camp.

<u>Dates:</u> June 12th through July 13th. <u>Dead Periods:</u> July 14th- July 31st

Times: Monday-Thursday from 4-6pm each day.

Physicals-

Physicals will be May 31st from 6-8 pm in the gym office for all Frosh, JV and Varsity Players. Cost is \$20 for advanced payment at the finance office, and \$25 at the door. This is a major fundraiser for the training department. The original physical will be attached to your ticket to play paperwork. The summer camp needs a **copy** of the physical or your ticket to play. **Please do not hand in the original for the summer camp.**

Equipment Issue- July 13th

Each player planning on participating for Poway High's football team will be fitted for equipment. Tickets to Play will be issued on July 13th. You MUST have your "Ticket to Play" to be issued equipment. Make ups are August 1st.

Practices

Fall Camp practice will **begin August 1st**. From August 1st to the start of school there will be some days when we have two practices per day. There will be practice on Saturdays in our fall camp. **Practices are mandatory.** Any missed practices for whatever reason will impact playing time.
