### Spring Football

Spring football begins May 15<sup>th</sup> and continues through June 1<sup>st</sup>. It is an opportunity to prepare for the upcoming season. It is open to any Poway High School Student. Incoming frosh and students from other schools are not permitted to participate. A "Ticket to Play" is not a requirement for spring football. Practices are from 3-5 pm Monday-Thursday. Spirit Pack and cleats are required.

### Physicals

Physicals will be May 31<sup>st</sup> from 6-8 pm in the gym office for all Frosh, JV and Varsity Players. Cost is \$20 for advanced payment at the finance office, and \$25 at the door. This is a major fundraiser for the training department. The original physical will be attached to your ticket to play paperwork. The summer camp needs a **copy** of the physical or your ticket to play. **Please do not hand in the original for the summer camp.**

### Summer Camps – Medical form and Waiver

We hold an optional summer camp starting June 12<sup>th</sup>, and our "Titan Football Camps" club will participate in passing league tournaments and contests versus clubs in the area. This camp is conducted by coaches and is open to anyone from ages 12-18. It is an opportunity to train, lift, and participate in activities designed to prepare our student-athletes for competition. This camp is not affiliated with PUSD and not a requirement for participation for Poway High's football team. You must complete the Camp Medical form and waiver, sign up for an AAU membership, and return the forms along with your check to participate (your "Ticket to Play" is not required for this camp). The summer camp application, medical form, and waiver are located on our website. Tuition for the summer camp is \$200 and Due by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Need based scholarships are available for the summer camp.

Dates: June 12<sup>th</sup> through July 13<sup>th</sup>.

Times: Monday-Thursday from 5-7pm each day and there are some meetings at 4pm as well.

**Athletic Handbook- Issued by Poway High School Athletic Department** The Athletic Handbook contains forms that are required to receive your "Ticket to Play" (i.e., physical, Athletic Participation Signature Form, Residency, and Medical Information Release Form.) These forms are to be turned in on July 13<sup>th</sup> at equipment issue. When you turn in all necessary paperwork, you will be issued a "Ticket to Play" by the athletic department. ### Youth Football Camp

All of our Varsity Athletes not attending summer school are required to participate in our youth football camp that runs in the morning from June 12<sup>th</sup> to June 16<sup>th</sup>. This is an opportunity to earn community service hours.

### Equipment Issue July 13th

Each player planning on participating for Poway High's football team will be fitted for equipment. Again, you **MUST** have your "Ticket to Play" to be issued equipment. Make up equipment issue is on August 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Fall Camp** Fall Camp practice will **begin Tuesday, August 1<sup>st</sup>**. From August 1<sup>st</sup> to the start of school there will be some days when we have two practices per day. There will be practice on Saturdays in our fall camp.

**Practices are mandatory.** Any missed practices for whatever reason will impact playing time.

## **Fundraising**

We will conduct three fundraisers for the upcoming season (Titan Football Raffle, Community Discount Cards, and Community Support Drive.) Your efforts are greatly appreciated so we may run a first class program that provides many opportunities for our student-athletes. Parents have the opportunity to make a donation of \$550 to our football program in lieu of our fundraising efforts.
